

Paving the Way

In 1981, the first St. Louis Ronald McDonald House opened on West Pine as an 8-bedroom facility. Over the years, that facility expanded twice, including the purchase of the home next door, to become a 20-bed-room facility.

Due to the growing need for more bedrooms, a capital campaign was started in 1994 to build a second facility on Park Avenue, bringing the total rooms to 31. As a part of that campaign, the "Pave the Way Brick by Brick" program was begun and all available bricks have been purchased at that location (over 2,500). In April of 2003, we will open a new 8-unit apartment complex adjacent to the West Pine House. As such, we are offering special laser engraved bricks to be placed in the courtyard of that facility. The bricks at the new location will allow for more lines of engraving on the smaller (4 x 8) bricks and logos/small designs can be placed on the larger (8 x 8) bricks.

You can purchase a 4 x 8 laser engraved brick for \$100, with up to 4 lines of engraving at 20 characters per line. 8 x 8 bricks will be available for \$200 with up to 8 lines of engraving at 20 characters per line, or \$300 to include a logo or design on the brick. With your purchase, you will receive a tax deduction and can leave a permanent legacy to be seen and appreciated by thousands of families in the years to come.

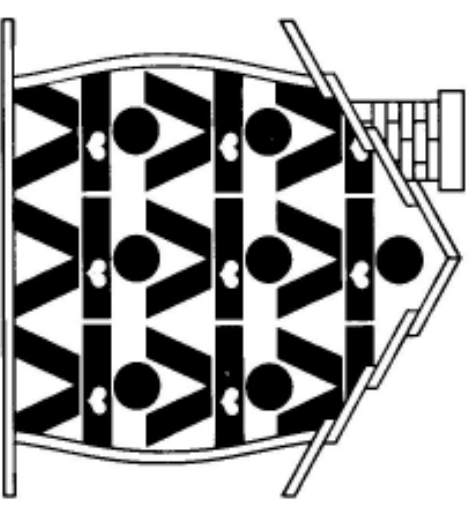
